

CITIZEN MEETING C.N. LANDS

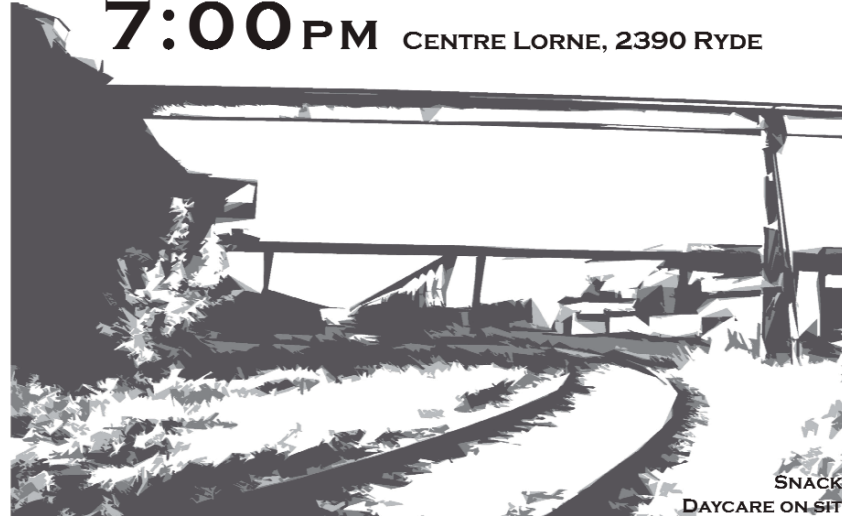

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The Action Watchdog (Action-Gardien) committee invites you to a Citizen's meeting to discuss the latest news on the development of the CN lands, and to discuss future actions.

- The City of Montreal and the Southwest borough have agreed that significant changes have to be made to the project before its approved.
- The borough is organizing a series of meetings with area stakeholders, including Action-Gardien, and also with the site owner, the CN and the AMT (Metropolitan Transport Agency).
- Victory! The borough is committed to calling a public meeting before any plan for the site is adopted.

We have to remain vigilant and ready to react!

Of course we welcome these commitments. However, nothing is guaranteed, and many questions remain unanswered.

- Will access to the industrial part of the proposed project be by Marc-Cantin street be made a priority?
- Will truck traffic be limited throughout the neighbourhood?
- Will Congregation Park be saved ?
- Will industrial activities respect our quality of life?
- Will residential areas respect the existing neighborhood, making it a great place for families, with parks, improved public transport and local services?
- Will "Building 7" be developed for community, cultural and social activities?

The future of the CN lands, a key to the future of our entire neighborhood !
